REMINDER – NURSERY PARENTS

If your child is born between 01.09.2020 and 31.08.2021 – It's time to apply for a full time place in the reception class – Letters have been sent out from the nursery class



The deadline to apply is 15th January 2025 via the Leicester City Council Admissions Team

Reminder – Parents must inform the school office if their child is absent from school. If your child's attendance is below 90%, medical evidence will be requested to authorise an absence from school. If your child is absent for 3 days or more, medical evidence will always be required.
